**The following scholarships are available for students entering the following years**

<b>Visual Arts</b>	Students entering Years 9 and 11
<b>Drama</b>	Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11
<b>Dance</b>	Students entering Years 7, 9 and 11

**Students entering Year 7 and applying for a Drama or Dance Scholarship must be prepared to attend an audition process and perform for a judging panel.**

**Students entering Year 9 and applying for a Visual Arts Scholarship must present the following**

- Major artworks undertaken in years 7 & 8 demonstrating a intuitive handling of materials and originality or uniqueness
- Visual Process Diaries reflecting a willingness to record artistic practices on a unique or more original level
- School reports for Visual Arts in Years 7 and 8
- Outline workshops or outside tuition undertaken by the student
- A letter from the student explaining why they are deserving of the scholarship

**Students entering Year 11 and applying for a Visual Arts Scholarship must present the following**

- Body of Work undertaken in Years 9 and 10 which demonstrates skill, intuitive handling of materials, originality or uniqueness
- Visual Process Diaries reflecting a willingness to record artistic practices on a unique or more original level
- School reports for Visual Arts in Years 9 and 10
- Outline workshops or outside tuition undertaken by the student
- A letter from the student explaining why they are deserving of the scholarship
