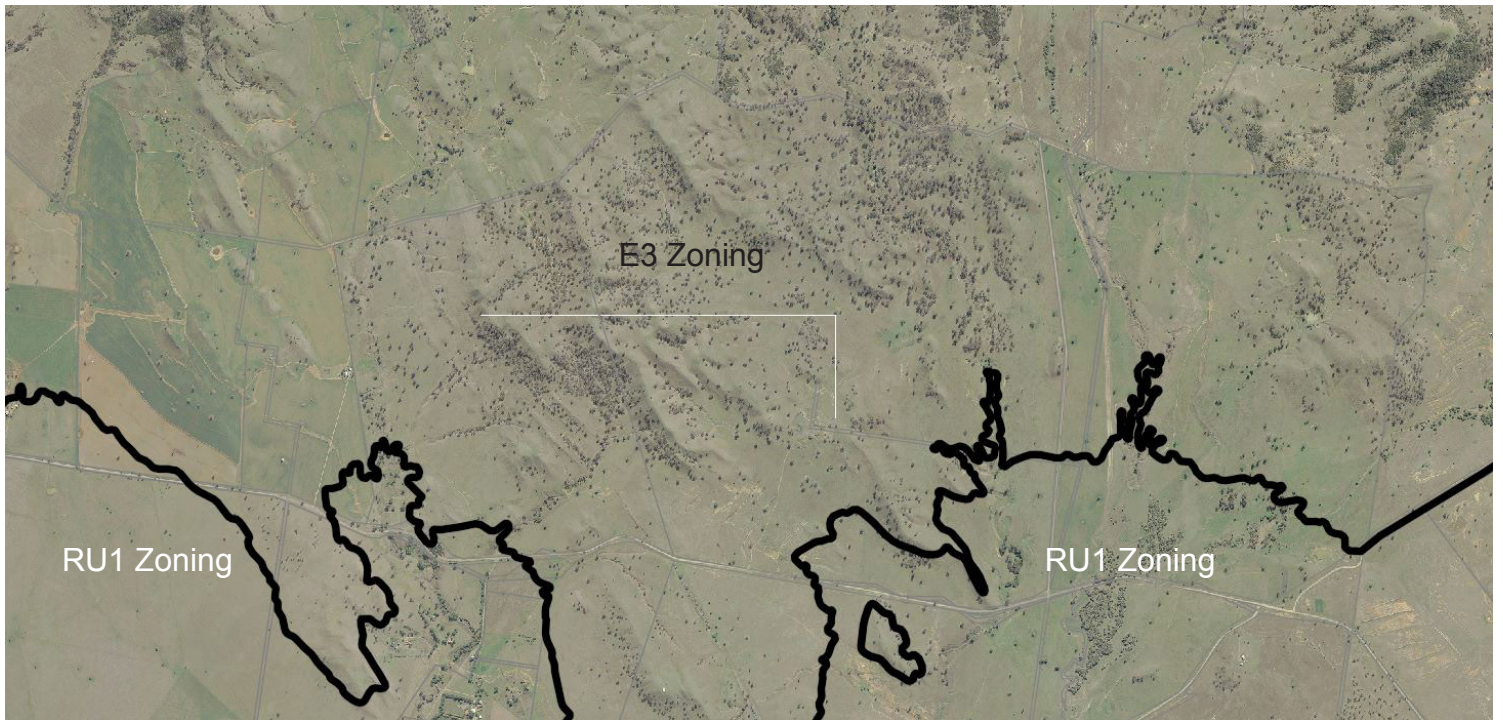


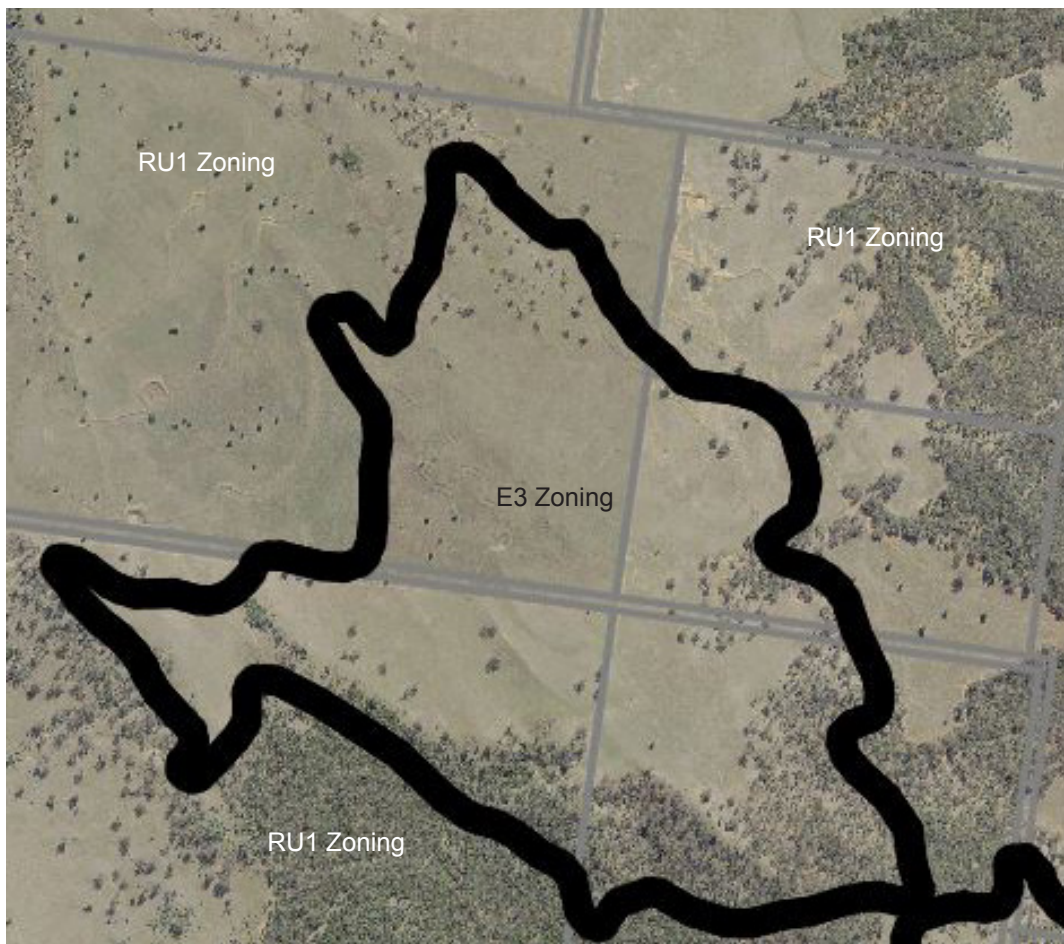
Aerial of "Myall Park", "Rangari", "Carranya" & "Westgrove"

Demonstrates that the hillscape (zoned E3) is not significant.

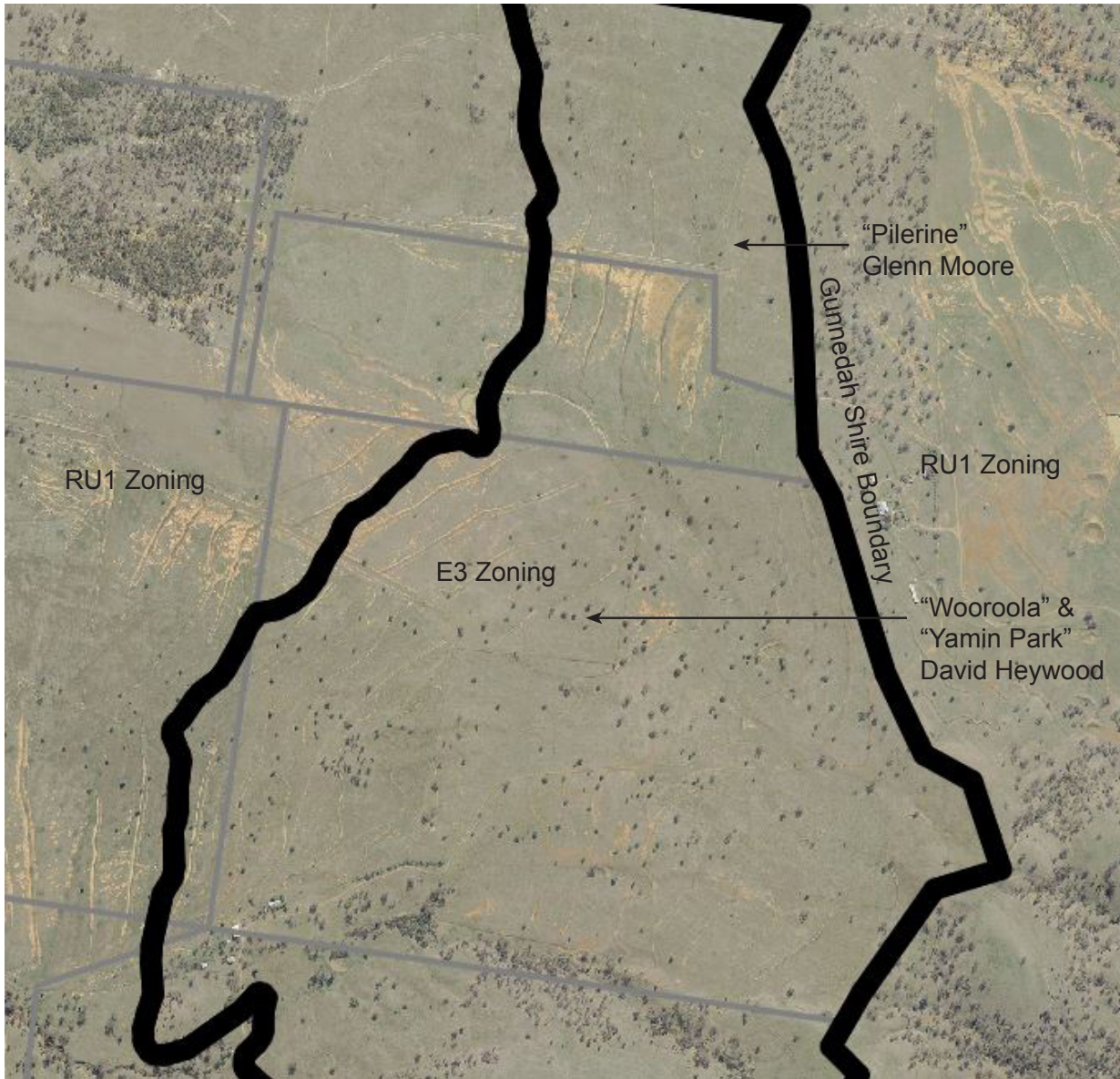

NATIONAL SECURITY (WHEAT INDUSTRY STABILIZATION) REGULATIONS.

3. On this 31st day of January, the above-named is/are licensed to grow Wheat in the season 1945/46, on the Registered farm referred to, as follows:

FOR GRAIN (Basic <u>75</u> acres, Special <u>65</u> acres)	<u>140</u> acres.
FOR HAY AND GRAZING	<u>10</u> acres.
Total Area Licensed for Wheat for all purposes	<u>150</u> acres.

4. This Licence is issued subject to the following conditions, and will remain in force until 1st March, 1946, unless sooner cancelled.

CONDITIONS.

- (a) The Licensee shall not sow with wheat a greater area than the number of acres shown on the Licence.
- (b) The Licensee shall not sow wheat for grain on any land other than on a registered farm in respect of which he is licensed.
- (c) The Licensee shall not harvest for grain any wheat sown for hay or grazing or sown in contravention of the Wheat Industry Stabilization Regulations.
- (d) Cancellation of the Registration Certificate attached to the wheat farm in respect of which he is licensed shall cancel the right of the Licensee to harvest any wheat sown under the licence.
- (e) The Licensee shall comply with such other conditions as the Minister for Commerce and Agriculture notifies by Order published in the Gazette.

APPEALS.

Any appeal against this Licence should be lodged, in writing, with the Chairman, Wheat Industry Stabilization Committee, Box 39A, G.P.O., Sydney, within fourteen days of the date hereof.

IMPORTANT: KEEP THIS LICENCE CAREFULLY. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE IT WHEN ORDERING CORNSACKS AND CLAIMING COMPENSATION OR FOR INSPECTION IF DEMANDED.
