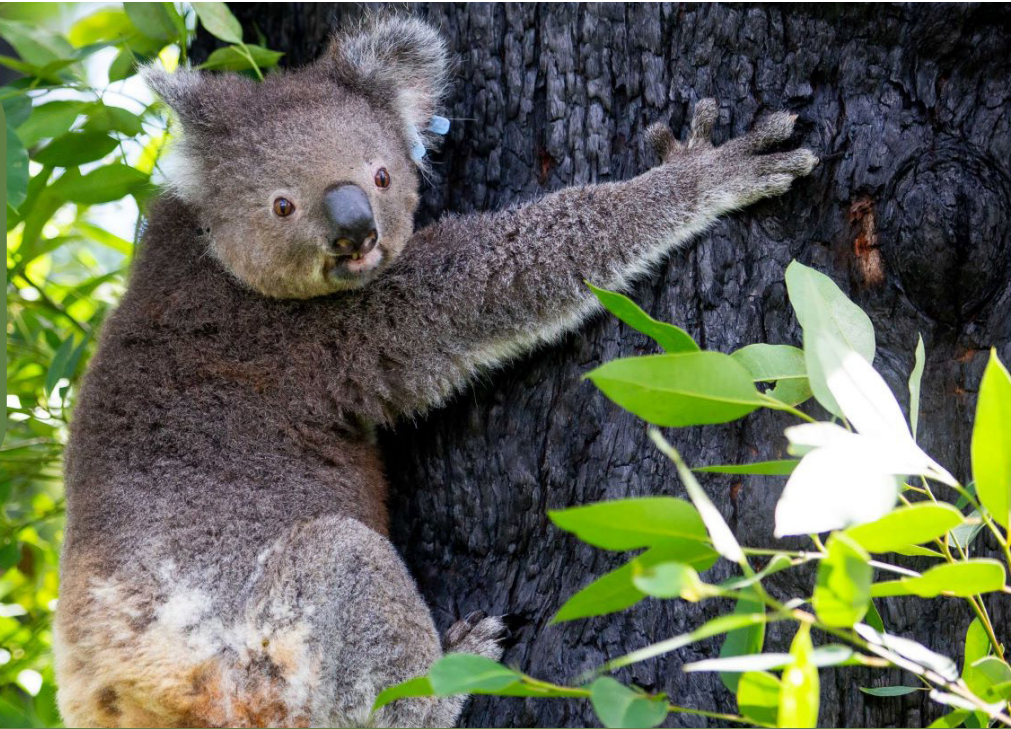


## What do we do at the Port Macquarie Koala Hospital?



### The 6 R's are:

Rescue | Rehabilitate | Release | Research | Restore | Repopulate



#### **Rescue**

We rescue approximately 250 koalas every year from across NSW.

#### **Rehabilitate**

We have a clinic where we look after koalas, and an intensive care unit where we can monitor them closely.

#### **Release**

We release koalas back into the wild where they can live as wild animals again.

#### **Research**

We research koala diseases, soil and food tree health, pathogens and drug therapies.

#### **Restore**

We grow koala food trees to feed sick and injured koalas at the hospital.

#### **Repopulate**

We are currently developing the world's first wild koala breeding program, which will help to increase the number of koalas in the wild!



The Port Macquarie Koala Hospital rescues koalas in the wild that are sick or injured.

Often koalas that have injuries are so high up in the trees that it can be difficult to rescue them!

“Koalas are wild animals and capturing them is not easy. It should only be done by experienced and qualified professionals.”

## Why do Koalas need rescuing?

### Chlamydia

Koalas are affected by a horrible disease caused by Chlamydia bacteria, which is infectious and affects the koala's eyes and internal organs.

### Being hit by a car

Often roads cross right through the habitat of a koala, which can lead to koalas being hit by cars. This is especially common in areas where koalas have to live near humans.

### Diseases

Koalas can also be affected by other diseases, such as cancers and fungal infections.

### Burns

Koalas are not good at escaping fires, and during the bushfire season we often have to rescue them and provide care and treatment.



## How do we rescue Koalas?

To rescue koalas, we use a long pole with a flag and bells attached to the end. We hold this above the koala and make lots of noise with it, which the koala does not like and it climbs down the tree.





# KOALA CONSERVATION

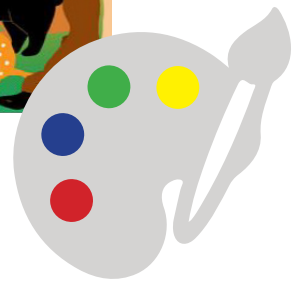

-  A roadside camera that can detect injured koalas and tell drivers to slow down
