Tools Needed: 10mm Wrench

- 1. Dislodge the Latch Rod by removing the Cotter Pin.
- 2. Slide the Latch Rod out of the Bracket; retain Cotter Pin and Retaining Pin.
- 3. Using the 10mm Wrench, remove the two M6 Nuts and Washers.
- 4. Remove old Latch Rod Bracket and install the new Bracket. Note: the flange must face towards the center of the vehicle.

- 5. Using the 10mm Wrench torque the M6 Nuts to 10 Nm.
- 6. Reinstall the Latch Rod, Retaining Pin, and Cotter Pin by following steps 1-5 in reverse.
