Tools Needed: Scissors/Diagonal Cutters, Pliers (Optional)



- 1. Open the Panel Door.
- 2. Firmly grip the Spoiler Seal and pull up to begin removing the Spoiler Seal. Pliers can be used to grip seal if needed.
- 3. Work the Spoiler Seal loose along the length of the Rear Door.
- 4. Unroll the new Spoiler Seal and press onto the Lip of the Rear Door. Make sure the long side of the Seal is facing toward the inside.
- 5. Work the new Spoiler Seal along the Lip of the Rear Door making sure it is fully seated.
- 6. Using Scissors/Diagonal Cutters, trim the seal on either end to have a 7/8" 1" gap between the edge of the Door and Spoiler Seal.
