Tools Needed: 10 mm Security Hex Key, 5 mm Hex Key, Scissors/Diagonal Cutters, Pliers (Optional)



- 1. Open the Panel Door.
- 2. Using the 10 mm Security Hex Key, remove the J-Hooks from the Bed Clamps.
- 3. Team lift the rack 18" toward the rear of the vehicle.
- 4. Using the 5 mm Hex Key, remove the four M6 Bolts from the Front Panel. The Front Panel can now be opened.
- 5. Firmly grip the Spoiler Seal and pull to remove the Spoiler Seal. Pliers can be used to grip seal if needed.
- 6. Unroll the new Spoiler Seal and press onto the Lip of the Front Panel. Make sure the Long Side of the Seal is facing toward the inside.
- 7. Work the new Spoiler Seal along the lip of the Front Panel making sure it is fully seated.
- 8. Scissors/Diagonal Cutters can be used to trim the seal if needed. The seal should be flush to each edge of the Front Panel.
- 9. Repeat Steps 2-4 to reinstall the rack. Torque the Bed Clamps to 30-38 Nm. Torque the M6 Bolts to 7 Nm.
