


SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



WARNING

- · Follow instructions for proper assembly, mounting and loading procedures.
- · Check tightness of all bolts and screws periodically.
- · Make sure the rack and your vehicle receiver are in good working condition before each use.
- · Do not use rack off-road.
- · Do not use hitch extenders with this product.
- · Do not use rain or wind-covers or tarps with this product.

NOTICE

- · Place the front tire clamp next to the front fork.
- Do not take through automatic carwash.

- No pasar por el túnel de lavado automático.


- Suivez les instructions pour les procédures appropriées d'assemblage, de montage et de chargement.

- Ne passez pas par le lave-auto automatique.


Vehicle Installation


Insert the rack into the hitch receiver and align the hitch pin holes, then insert the hitch pin and clevis over the end of the pin. Push or pull the rack in the hitch receiver to remove rattle caused by the hitch pin and turn the knob until tight.



Tension Knobs


After pins are in place, tighten the small black knobs to reduce wobble.






Loading Bikes

Load the heaviest end of bike first. Feed straps through the ratchets and pull tight. Use two straps on the top tube and one on the seat tube. Alternate bike directions when loading.




Tilt Feature

Remove lower pin and place in hole shown. This will allow you to lower the rack and access your trunk or hatch.



Fold and Stow

The Beta comes pre-assembled and packaged in the stow position. When you are ready to use the rack, pull the pins and unfold the hitch tube and upper arms into position and re-insert pins.

Küat RV Compatibility Warning

Küat's receiver hitch-mounted bicycle racks may be used with some recreational vehicles (RVs) as described below. Many types of RVs subject the rack and bicycles on it to high forces and extreme movements. As a result, Küat does not recommend using our receiver hitch-mounted products on RVs that will likely expose the rack to unacceptable conditions.

Küat's standard warranty will cover use of any of its 2-inch receiver hitch-mounted bicycle racks on motorhomes (as defined in 49 C.F.R. 571.3) satisfying all of the following requirements:

The receiver hitch is directly attached to the motorhome chassis, not just to the bumper;

The rear-most point of the receiver hitch where the bicycle rack will be attached is no more than 64 inches from the rear axle of the motorhome; and

The vehicle is a class B type motorhome as described below.

Class B type motorhomes are commonly known as van conversions and comprise a completed van-type vehicle which has been altered to provide temporary living quarters. Class B type motorhomes have a gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 lbs or less.

In addition, the 2 inch receiver Transfer™ v2 and the 2-inch receiver Piston Pro X may be used on RVs (both motorhomes and trailers) satisfying all of the following requirements: The receiver hitch is directly attached to the RV chassis, not just to the bumper; and The bicycle rack is in the 2-bike configuration with no add-on unit attached.

Please check the Warnings section of the User Guide for load weight limits applicable to your rack when used on an RV. Lower weight limits apply.

Even if the conditions above are met, any RV may be operated in a way that will expose Küat's products to conditions that they are not designed to handle. The operator of the RV is responsible to operate the RV in a manner that will not overload the rack, such as by excessive speed over rough roads or speed bumps, rapid turning movements, driving the RV over changes in gradient that will bring the rack in contact with the ground, or other similar actions.
