Guidelines for Acceptable Use of Kudos Kids & Co Policy for Family Members

Purpose:

To protect the privacy of all children using the Kudos Kids & Co platform by providing family members with clear guidance on appropriate content-sharing and interaction practices.

Guidelines:

1. Respect for Privacy & Consent Awareness:

1.1 Family members are expected to respect the privacy of all children on the platform. Photos or content featuring children other than their own must not be reposted or shared publicly without the explicit consent of the other child's parents or guardians.

1.2 Family members should be aware that some students may not have parental consent to participate in Kudos Kids & Co. It is their responsibility to ensure that any content they share does not infringe on these consent restrictions.

1.3 **Administrative family members** are responsible for regularly reviewing and managing who has access to view their child's account on the Kudos Kids & Co platform. This should be reviewed frequently to ensure only appropriate individuals have access.

2. Positive and Appropriate Feedback:

2.1 Family members should provide positive and appropriate feedback to children on the platform. Encouraging, constructive, and respectful comments are essential to creating a supportive and uplifting environment.

2.2 Inappropriate comments may be removed from the platform, as teachers regularly moderate all content to ensure it adheres to community standards.

3. Reporting Concerns:

Family members who observe content that may violate the privacy of other students are encouraged to report it to their child's classroom teacher or the school administration promptly.

4. Consequences for Policy Violations:

Family members who do not follow these guidelines may face restricted access to the Kudos Kids & Co platform, or other actions as determined by the school administration.
