Dear Kwanda,

April was a big month! Together, your two clinics served **708 people** across Lagos -- mothers, children, grandparents, and working adults who had nowhere else to turn for free, quality healthcare.

Safe City had its best month of 2026 so far, crossing 398 patients -- well above the 300 target and a huge leap from March. The new team has clearly found its footing and the community is responding. At **Care Circle**, 310 patients came through the doors in Itire-Surulere, keeping the clinic comfortably above target for a second month running.

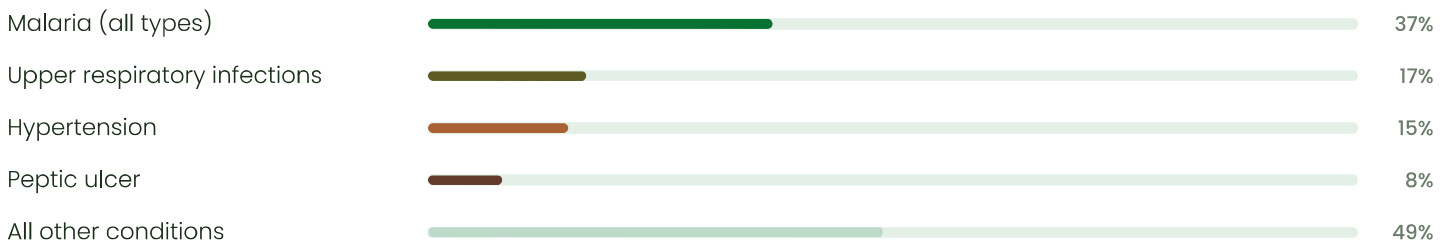

WHO WE ARE REACHING

The average Care Circle patient lives on **\$5.44 per person per month** -- a household of four surviving on ₦28,265 (~\$20.19). The global poverty line is \$2.15. For these families, free care is not a convenience -- it is the only option.

WHERE PATIENTS CAME FROM

Patients traveled from **Itire, Ijesh, Kilo, and Lawanson** to reach Care Circle, showing how the clinic's reputation continues to spread across Surulere and beyond.

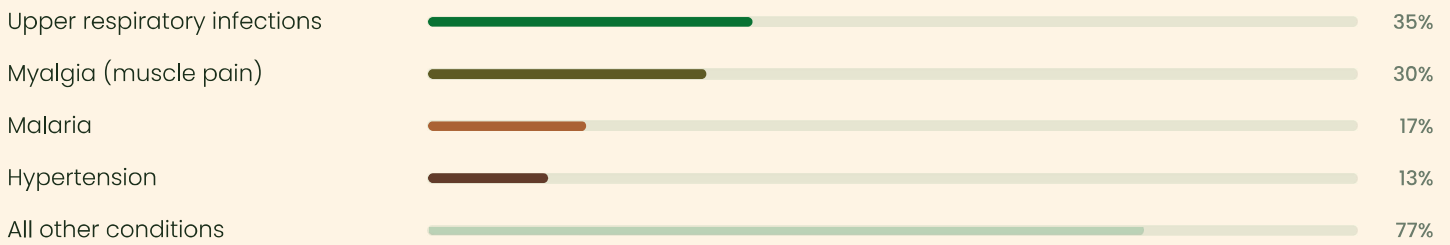

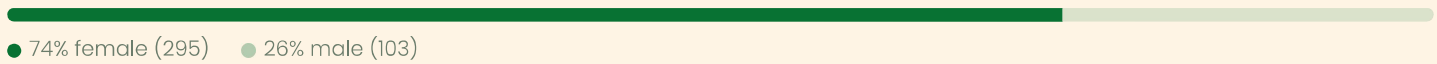

WHO WE ARE REACHING

Safe City patients live on an average of **\$9.22 per person per month** -- a household of four on **₦52,323** (~\$37.37). Still well below the poverty line and still without any affordable alternative for primary care.

WHERE PATIENTS CAME FROM

Patients came from **Oworoshoki and Bariga (5.3 km away)**. Safe City had its strongest month of 2026 so far, a sign that trust in the new team is growing fast.

Sustainability in action: Care Circle's community plastic waste collection centre converted waste into cash again this month, directly supporting clinic operations. Each bag collected also eliminates a mosquito breeding site -- cutting malaria risk in the same community the clinic treats for it. One act, two impacts.

Your impact keeps growing

Mrs. Adeyemo is on her third visit. Mrs. Yetunde came to see for herself after hearing about the clinic -- and left a believer. These are not one-off visits. These are families building a relationship with free healthcare that they trust.

Together, your two clinics have now served **9,879 people** since launching. That number keeps climbing -- and it's because of you.
