HOW TO APPLY

Intensive English Program (IEP):

1. IEP application (www.csun.edu/go/applyIEP) with nonrefundable fee (\$150 or \$100 USD, see **Dates and Costs** table above) - OR - IEP with Conditional Admission application (www.csun.edu/go/applyIEPCA) with nonrefundable fee (\$250 or \$200 USD, see **Dates and Costs** table above)
2. First session tuition fee
3. Evidence of financial support
4. Copy of passport

Additional requirements for IEP with Conditional Admission:

5. Cal State Apply application (www2.calstate.edu/apply) with nonrefundable fee (\$70 USD)
6. Official transcript from high school or college/university
7. Proof of graduation from high school or college/university
8. For graduate applicants – Visit www.csun.edu/graduate-studies/prospective-students for additional requirements.

NOTE: Applicants must be at least 18 years old. All supporting documents are due at the time of application. All official documents must be submitted in their original language, together with an English translation.
