

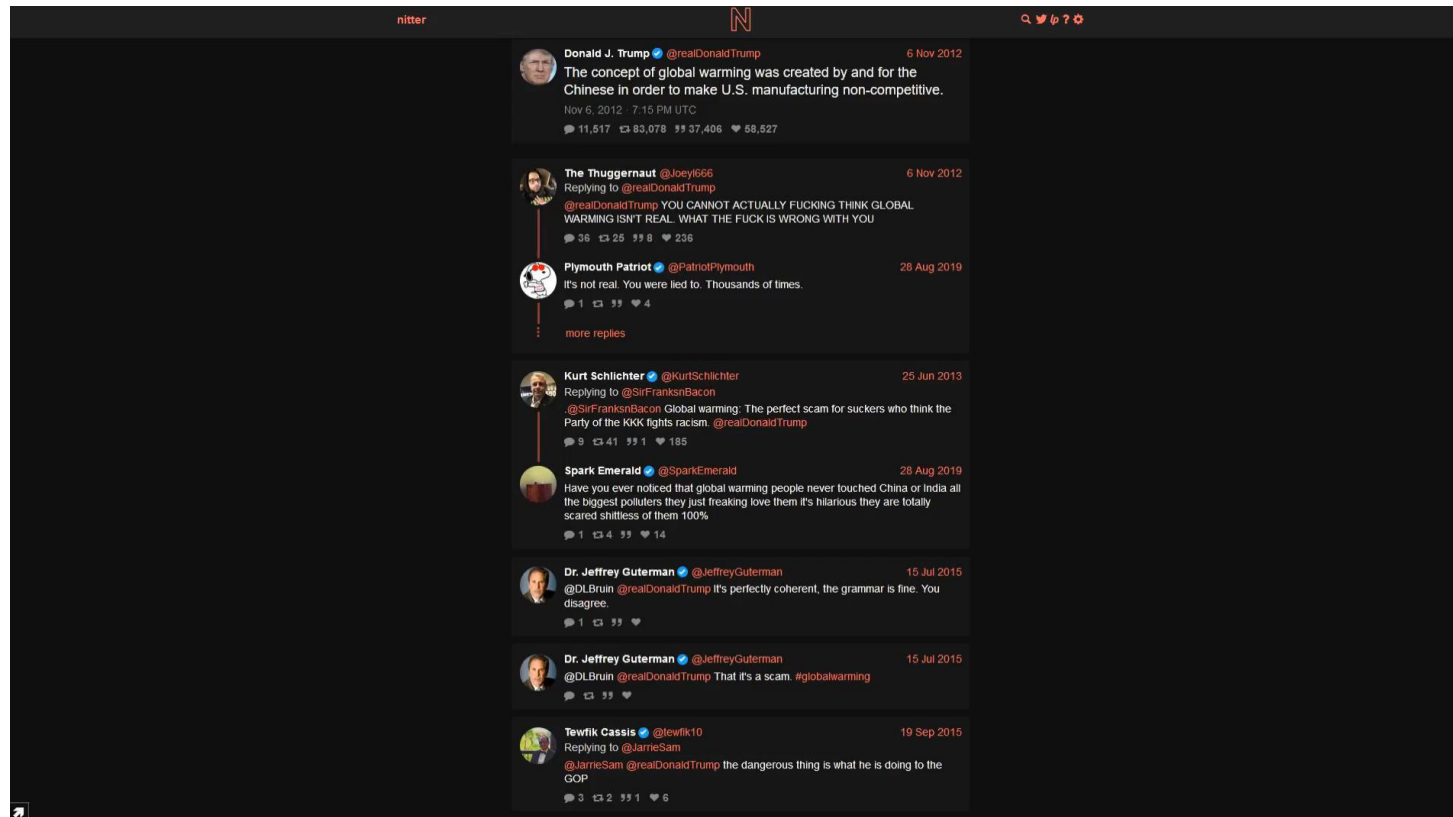

Why just advise?

- ▶ Option 1: use AI to rephrase a given tweet
- ▶ Option 2: use AI to write a new tweet
- ▶ AI is limited. Tweets are too short for AI to understand context enough to suggest good alternatives.
- ▶ AI-generated tweets make users dependent and stunt learning. Users become more proficient by crafting tweets themselves.
