

Open Plugin

Open Plugin enabling language models to utilize external data and capabilities through plugins such as search, question answering, and commonsense reasoning.



The Problem: Language Models Are Limited to Their Training Data

- Language models today can only access the data they were trained on
- Real-world AI requires access to vast, disparate data sources



The Solution: Open Plugin

- Defines an interface for creating and installing plugins
- Developers can create plugins accessing: -- Proprietary data -- Open data -- Online services
- Plugins run externally but interact with the language model
- Enables models to access external data and capabilities



How It Works

- Developers implement plugins that access data sources and capabilities
- LLMs programmatically call the language model and send data
- The language model processes the data and returns a response
- Plugins receive and handle the response
- This allows the language model to tap into diverse data and services
