## Understanding the problem

- Data Protection Leads (DPL) in the UK are advised by and work with Data Protection Officers (DPO).
- Some DPLs and organisations do not have designated DPOs
- This means that all the data protection legal work falls onto them

#### Referencing GDPR

- Confusing Lots of legal jargon!
- Massive time spent looking up legislations and meanings

#### Providing Redacted Documents

- Time consuming A lot of time spent thinking of the phrasing
- Redacting documents is a slow and manual process


# Project objective:

Introducing Claude Data Protection Assistant:


#### Two main features:

- Advice Get advice on GDPR
- Redact Redact your documents

#### Noteworthy mentions:

- Made on bubble.io
- Users provide their own API key
- File upload
- OCR plugin for image to text

#### Claude Advice



- Use the drop down menu to choose which section of the GDPR to query
- Whole message history (up to context token limit) is prompted, keep context while you query for advice

## **Uploading Files**

Files can be uploaded (PDF or image is OK). OCR plugin automatically extracts text from file!

#### Claude Redact

Select the PDF file you want redacted. In the file manager window, click on 'select' in the pop up window to extract the text from the file. Then fill in what redactions are required before clicking 'redact' to send to Claude.

#### Start by choosing a PDF file:

**DF file:** PDF File Manager




