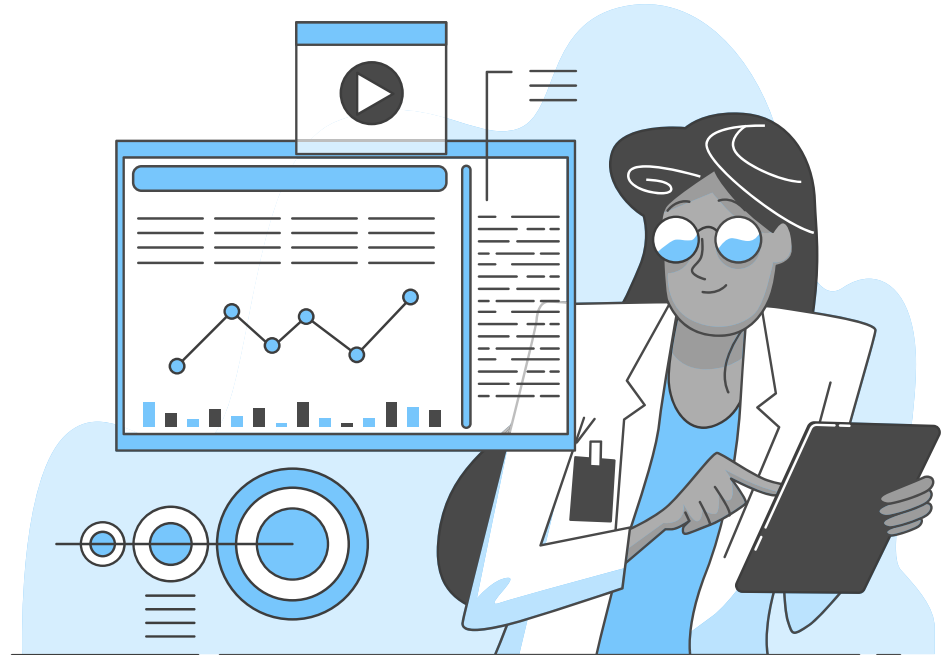

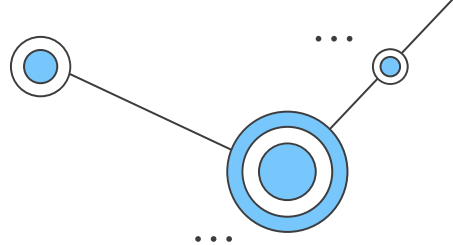

Problem



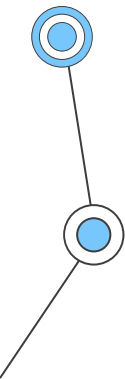
In 2021-2022, approximately **8.9 million** Americans moved between states. Of these:

The Single Most Compelling Number:

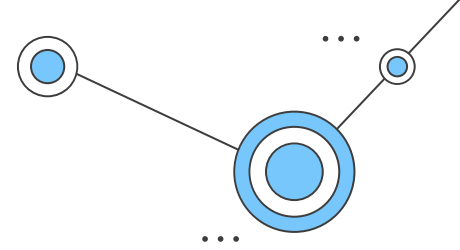
73% (roughly 6.5 million people) reported significant difficulties with documentation and compliance requirements, spending an average of **\$4,300** per family on administrative tasks alone - resulting in a total economic burden of approximately **\$28 billion** annually in direct costs and lost productivity.

This single number (**\$28 billion** annual economic impact) powerfully demonstrates the massive scale of the interstate migration problem and the urgent need for an AI-driven solution like StateShift to streamline the process.

To put it simply: Every year, interstate migration challenges cost Americans the equivalent of the entire annual budget of many federal agencies, making this a critical problem worth solving.

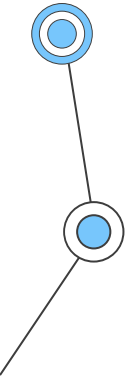


The Challenge

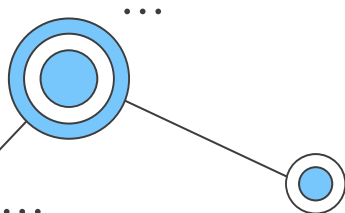

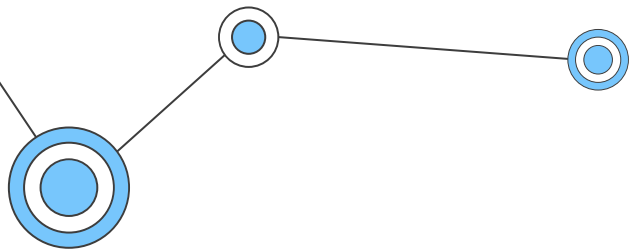
Cost of shiting to Ohio including utilites and house rent
