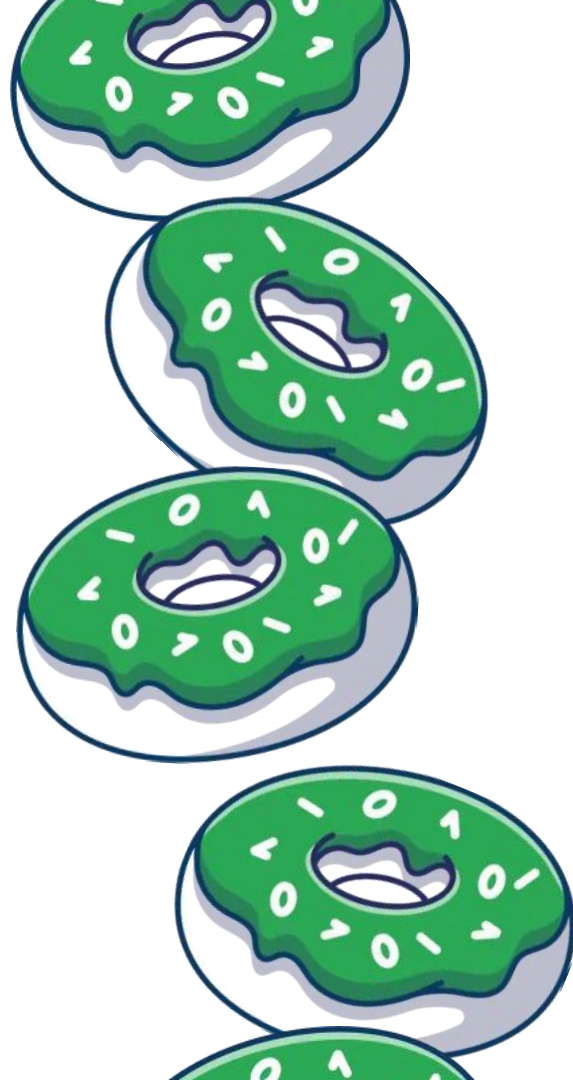

Well received speed dating between the attending developers

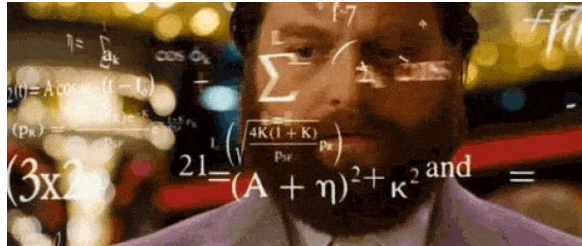


## BUT NOW...
