Rabbi Norman Lamm has referred your letter of January 20th to me for reply. Rabbi Lamm is leaving for South Africa on February 2nd and, therefore, could not reply himself. On the other hand, he did not want your letter to remain unanswered until his return four weeks hence.

In order for us here to pursue your request to pay the expenditure of your private tuition, we shall need an official letter from your Rosh Yeshivah, Rav Shlomo Zalman Auerbach, to the effect that these arrangements for private tutoring are being made with his consent and upon his recommendation and that your progress is periodically ascertained by him or another Rosh Yeshivah of Kol Torah assigned by him to examine you. Further, we need to know the amount involved per month.

Upon receipt of the above certification and information, we shall, I assure you, give your request our most sympathetic consideration.
