I would hereby like to make an official request of you to permit a slight change in the format of my forthcoming dissertation for the Bernard Revel Graduate School.

The reason for this is the great number of "broken" lines of Hebrew and English which will be confined to the footnotes, and which will therefore make inordinately technical demands in the typing if I were to follow the stated procedure.
