I know how close you are to Jakob Michael. You know that Federation now has two Chassidic camps-Mogen Avraham and Sternberger.

We plan to open a third camp this summer next to Mogen Avraham in the Bear Mountain area. We are looking for a sponsor for about \$15,000 to \$20,000. We would be glad to name the camp in his name. The reason the cost is very modest is that the Bear Mountain area is rented to Federation camps at a very reasonable fee, therefore obviating the need to buy property.

Could you arrange for a meeting at which time I could discuss with with Mr. Michael to whom, I believe, this should be of great interest.

You may know that Mogen Avraham is named for Albert Joffe, who gave us the money to make that camp possible in 1961.
