In accordance with your suggestion I today called Dean Mirsky and asked him to arrange for the two Russian girls to be permitted to attend Stern College, pending your handling of the matter.

The two young ladies are [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. It took a great deal of effort to persuade them to enrol in the College, but they were accepted on their own merits. We have enabled to arrange with a private foundation to pay up to \$700.- for each student. This money will be forthcoming towards the end of the first semester.
