Dear Moe,

I am sending you herewith enclosed, the minutes of the last meeting of the Executive Committee on Russian Jewry.

Your visit has engendered a tremendous amount of enthusiasm among the various Committees and individuals who are active in the field. It would be a pity if this would be dissipated owing to inaction on your end.

I received a cable from Rabbi Levovitz advising us that a Committee is in formation. However, if the momentum is slowed, it will not only create a credibility gap here, but will deprive us of doing the job which needs to be done. If a delegation is to go to the States to raise funds, we must do it immediately. If you wish, you may want to suggest names of people who should constitute this delegation.
