- 6.1 1. Necessary virtues & unnecessary virtues
- " " - if he hasn't got - bad! } hands
  - " " - if he has - so what? }
- unnecessary " - if he hasn't - so what? } musical talent
- " .. - if he has - good! }

## 2. Torah - necessary virtue -

- if you have it - תְּהִלָּתֶךָ because  
רַגְלֵיךְ - these are your hands + feet,  
necessary for life. Don't pin it on lapel
- if you haven't - terrible - a cripple - כַּפְרֵךְ  
רַגְלֵיךְ - you were created for Torah as  
you were created for walking + thinking +  
speaking.

## 3. a bushy cobra of last generation - רַבְבָּה כְּנַעֲןָה עַמּוֹדָה

True, if you are forced by unfavorable conditions  
as poverty, illness etc., God will not  
take you to task for your lack of knowledge  
about it. "But you'll remain an עַמּוֹדָה פֶּשֶׁת!  
Our excuse will not make you a פֶּשֶׁת".

## 4. end of 2 1/13 (R) read: פָּנָא אֶת־צְדָקָתֶךָ A man who was drowning can empty his lungs from water. A person can empty his "lungs" from air. But a person can't empty himself from lungs - פָּנָא אֶת־צְדָקָתֶךָ - translate:

"Torah is a tiny finn which you can't empty yourself".

5. joke about Hebrew scholar, freethinker but friendly +  
Jews as people, who underwent conversion to Christianity  
to escape restrictions on Jews. Christianity = נָזֶר  
(Nazarene). After Jews needed favor from him, Rabbi  
Wrote to him נָזֶר צְדָקָתֶךָ. He answered, my conversion didn't  
help anyone - נָזֶר צְדָקָתֶךָ, I'm still here!
