Dear Dr. Weiss:

Please don't read this letter until after you return from the convention in Washington.

Now that you are back, I want to refer you to the letter to me from Jhirad, a photocopy of which is enclosed.

I inquired from the Admissions Department of Yeshiva University concerning the [REDACTED] boy. The information they gave me is as follows. As of June, 1961 the records indicate that he is not eligible for Yeshiva College. There is a possibility, however, that the boy is ready for Yeshiva High School.

The matter, therefore, rests with you. May I suggest very respectfully that in writing to Jhirad in the matters that he brought to your attention, you also dispose of the [REDACTED] problem one way or the other.

All the best luck at the convention and try hard not to fall asleep during all those speeches.
