As you know, the West Side Jewish community has recently begun to organize a Jewish Community Council.

I have every reason to expect that it will be a significant and effective instrument for the enhancement of our goals in our neighborhood.

In order for us to be sure that it will fully serve the purpose of the entire Jewish community, and not neglect our special Orthodox interests, it is important that we appoint active and responsible delegates to the Council.

May I therefore urge you most strongly to appoint three people, one delegate and two alternates, as your representatives. They may be men or women -- many of us chose women because they are more available at the times that meetings are usually set.
