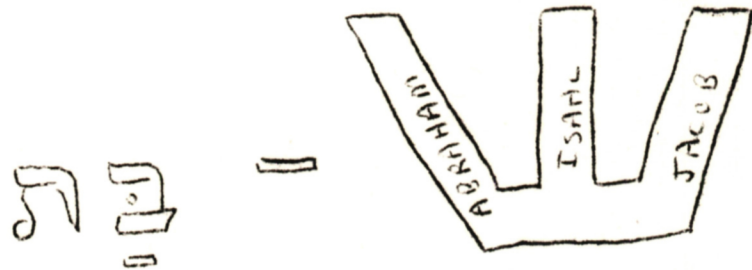

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### GLOSSARY

1. ALMA D'PIRUDA - the world of division, or disunity
2. GE'ULAH - Redemption
3. KABBALAH - receiving or tradition: the name for Jewish Mysticism
4. KALAH - bride
5. MALKSAH - the Queen
6. MIDAS HA'DIN - the Divine attribute of Justice
7. MIDAS HA'RACHAMIM - the Divine attribute of Mercy
8. NEKUDAH ILA'AH - the "upper Sabbath point", i.e. the concentrated spirituslity of Time, identifiable with Shechinah
9. NESHAMAH YESEIRAH - the additional soul acquired on the Sabbath
10. SE'UDASSA DI'MEHMENUSAH - "Meal of Faith", i.e. one of the three Sabbath meals
11. SHECHINAH - the Divine Presence: G-d in His immanence, dwelling among His creatures
12. SHECHINAH TATA'AA - Man: the Divine presence on earth
13. SHIR HA'SHIRIM - The Song of Songs, one of the Books of the Bible
14. TESHUVAH (MEI'AHAVAH) - Repentance (out of love)
15. YICHUD - unification
16. (SEFER HA)ZOHAR - (The Book of) Splendor - main source of the Kabbalah
