Be it remembered, that MEYER SAMUEL LAMM then residing at number 78 South First Street, City of Brooklyn, State of New York, who previous to his naturalization was a citizen of Poland, having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and at a Stated term of the District Court of the United States, held at Brooklyn, on the 11th day of August, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-five the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States for at least five years and in this State for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the filing of his petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States, had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.
