Dear Abraham:

I am writing to you again on one special point.

The Sunday that we went touring the villages on the Konkan, the younger Mr. Benjamin, son of the solicitor, whose car we used, broached to me the matter of investments by American Jewish businessmen in industry in Bombay that would make possible the employment of a larger number of Indian Jews.

I have looked into the matter and there is a possibility that something may be done. I would ask that you have Mr. Benjamin write out his proposals in detail and submit them to Mr. Moses Feuerstein, at the U.O.J.C.A., 84 Fifth Avenue, New York 11, New York.

Regards to everyone, and tell them not only am I keeping them in mind but I am working hard on Indian matters.
