Dear Rabbi Lamm,

I have received the copy of your letter to [redacted] and as you requested will use it only with the greatest of caution. Frankly, I have not visited [redacted] in quite a while and am somewhat on the outside at present.

There have been a great many developments in Geshet recently. We have had two radio shows on Geshet (Galei Zahal: 7 minutes and Kol Yisroel: ½ hour) and an excellent article on Geshet appeared in last week's Maariv Lanoar. As our seminars expand, more and more people are beginning to hear about and talk about Geshet.

The most exciting thing, however, has been the internal developments within Geshet. Under separate cover I am sending you a carbon copy of my latest "Dear All" letter, i.e. my letters to the newly formed Geshet cabinet. This letter, I believe, will give you a fair idea of where we stand and what we're doing. *I am also enclosing a xerox copy of the [Hebrew] article.*
