Dear Rabbi Lamm:

I am pleased to advise you that your application to serve on the staff of CAMD MORASHA as Educational Staff Associate has been approved. Your duties are to include those customarily assigned to camp staff members in your category, as interpreted by the Camp Director and described in the Staff Manual.

You will be required to make yourself available for staff orientation sessions at least twice monthly during the two months preceding opening of camp. Your staff responsibilities at camp will commence on June 27th 1965 and teminate on Aug 24 1965 as per attached letter
