Not everyone is aware of the prohibition against wearing garments made of wool and linen mixed together. It is a Biblical commandment, recorded in Deuteronomy 22:11. It is thus incumbent upon us to observe this commandment properly.

Fortunately, because of the efforts of the Shatnez Laboratory in Brooklyn, it has become a simple matter for everyone to observe this law, free of charge in most cases. Either bring your garment for inspection to the Laboratory at 203 Lee Avenue in Brooklyn, or call EV 7-8520 and they will give you the names of establishments nearest your home who engage in this sacred work. An appointment for a man to come to your home to inspect your garment is available at a nominal fee.

By having your garment checked and then stamped with the "Shatnez-free" label of the Shatnez Laboratory, you will enjoy the knowledge that you have fulfilled this commandment in the proper way. For more details, call The Center office.

When using elite type move in margin ¼-inch on both sides to 7-inch width. TYPE DOUBLE spaced between parallel lines. Each typed line will equal 2 printed lines (2¼-inches wide) or 1 doubleline (5-inches wide). Type your copy in duplicate and retain 1 copy (one set) for yourself. Number your copy consecutively (fill in left hand corner, top of this page). If story continues, repeat caption on continuing page(s) and number.
