INSTALLATION OF OFFICERS AT CHANUKAH BANQUET 1955

- Looking over the list, I discover that there are a total of seven units that must be officially charged and installed. And I do not regard this as amere fortuitous coincidence. The number seven is a "magic number" in Jewish life. It is above all the number of days of the week, the symbol of the Creation of the world, and therefore the symbol of creativity as such. It is my hope and my prayer that this administration will fulfill that function of creativity on the pattern set down before it. For the work of the officers of a synagogue is much like the study of Torah IM YOM TAAZVENU YOMAYIM YAAZVEKA, neglect it for a day and it neglects you for twice that time. You cannot keep the status quo in a shul it's either ahead or backwards, either creative or, CHALILAH, destructive. Our installation, this evening, of each and evry one of the new administration is based on that proposition, the proposition that you must determine to be creative, else you harm this holy work which you have undertaken. Let us proceed then, with the intallation, on the pattern of the first seven days in which G-d created this Universe.
- 2.On the first day, G-d created Heaven and Earth and He also created Light and Darkness.

 The ability to distinguish between Light and Darkness, the duty of spreading light and subduing the forces of darkness, is a sacred one. In the first of the famous Dead Sea Scrolls discovered recently, an ancient Megillah whose authorship has not yet been determined beyon doubt, tells of the battle between the BNEI OR and BNEI CHOSHECH, the Children of Light and the Children of Darkness. The members of the Board must consider themselves the true BNEI OR, Children of Light. Upon you we will rely to bring great light into the congregation whom you are priveleged to serve. Upon you depends the future of the administration, and hence the future of Kodimoh. Apathy, indifference, pettiness and lack of vision serve only to enshroud a community in the darkness of eclipse.

 Loyalty, energy, breadth of vision illuminate it and its future. As I call upon you, the BNEI OR, Children of Light, I ask you to rise in your individual places.

3.(GABBAIM).

On the second day, G-d divided between the waters - some water above Heaven, some below it. G-d, on that second day, had the unenviable job of a sort of Divine Celestial Gabbai. He had to recognize that all the waters were deserving of a place in Heaven, and yet His honord were limited- some above some below. Gabbaim of Kodimoh too have the same problem. Every member of Kodimoh deserves the best Aliyah every single Shabbos - yet you must divide - some above, some below; some get only a Pesichah or Gelilah or Revii, others get the super-heavenly portion - such as Maftir or Shlishi or Shishi. 4. (Treasurer)

Unique in the creations of the third day was the creation of plants with the ability to reproduce themselves, the ability to bear fruit whoch would eventually become trees, living organisms in the image of the parent tree. It is therefore a unique privelege for me to install the next officer, our new treasurer. The very fact that this is the first year he has shown great interest destiny Kodimoh is in itself significant: significant because he demonstartes the creativity of a father who was EITZ PRI OSEH PRI LEMINEIHU, who has now born fruit IN KIND. It is an occasion of Nachass for all of us that that gallant bentlemen, Mr. Louis Katz, who served so long and so ably, and who has just t is year stepped down from his office, should now witness his son following in his footsteps as a guide and servant of this cong.

5. (SECRETARY)

On the fourth day, our Torah tells us, G-d created the sun and the moon and the all the planets and stars - in other words, the heavenly bodies. What more appropriate day to use in installing our next secy. A Heavenly Body indeed! Hehas my vote for the handsomest man in the entire administration. However, that is not why I regard the fourth day appropriate for him. I do so because he is acquiring experience in almost evry important office Kodimoh has to offer. His travelling star has been occupying many really important positions in the constellation of Kodimoh's administration.

I want personally to express my grat tude to and admiration for him for the dignified, unselfish and honorable way he has shown his layalty to Kodimoh and his concern for its welfare above all else.
