Dear Mr. Bachrach:

After finishing the enclosed letter, Rabbi Lamm received your letter of June 14 and he has asked me to respond to you as follows:

He will be pleased to accept the invitation of Rabbi Gutnick and the president of the Caulfield synagogue to occupy the pulpit on the Shabbat he will be spending at Caulfield.

He does not believe it necessary to give a subject for his talk. Perhaps it would be just as well to announce that Dr. Lamm will preach the sermon, and leave it without a title.

He accepts your suggestion to decline Rabbi Rapaport's invitation to speak at his synagogue, and he will be delighted to accept the invitation to meet with all the Orthodox rabbis at luncheon on Monday, July 17.
