Dear Norman:

I em writing you this note to tell you how impressed and thrilled I was at your presentation in the recent issue of Maition concerning the separation of sexes. I found it comprehensive and intelligible in a way that previous writings thereon have not been.

I have several suggestions to make that I would like you and the proper authorities to consider. They are all sort of inter-related.

I am wondering whether it might not be in order to have a simplified version made up that would be printed in bulk quantities and distributed wide-spread in our country. I say a simpler edition because your article is approximately 24 pages and even the intelligent layman, at least in my Congregation, would perhaps be discouraged in going through it. If it could be simplified and made half the size I think it could serve a better purpose.

Then I would like to see it spread in all the annual anglo-Jewish press and in addition a very substantial number of copies printed. I know that I could distribute a thousand in my own Congregation. I have an idea that distributing them to the Orthodox Jewish Community of New Orleans as a public service, would be a good thing. Certainly we ought to do something about this. Perhaps the Rabbinical Council and the Union can take part therein, but it surely deserves to be utilized to the very utmost.

I am planning to be at the convention and look forward to seeing you then. Nevertheless if you do have time, please drop me a note on these suggestions.
