

**What is the COVID-19 Rapid Response Fund (CRRF)?**

The CRRF was put in place to enable Langeloth to address organizations' urgent and critical needs that have arisen due to the COVID-19 global pandemic.

**How does the CRRF differ from Langeloth's established funding cycles and process?**

The CRRF supports unforeseeable needs that require a timely—days rather than months—review and decision process. Non-urgent requests will *not* be considered for the CRRF and must go through the standard [application process](#).

**What are the criteria for a CRRF grant?**

- Alignment with Langeloth's mission
- Work that will serve the field in this unprecedented time
- Capacity of the organization to fulfill the objectives and goals of their grant
- Demonstrate that the funds will be used to provide a timely and effective response to the COVID-19 pandemic or the pandemic's impact on the grantee

**What types and range of grants are appropriate for the CRRF?**

The amount will depend on the scale of the problem and the cost of the proposed response/remedy. For example, a grant for technology needs to work from home might be in the \$500–\$2,000 range, while other responses may require larger amounts. Additional funding can be requested following the submission and review of project activities, outcomes, and expenditures.

**Who is eligible to receive a CRRF grant?**

US-based 501(C)(3) organizations working in Langeloth's [fields of interest](#) are eligible to apply.
