Conversation Starter: Have some fun as you break the ice.

- What is your favorite genre of film?

Key Scriptures: Let God's word frame the conversation. Take a minute to read this selected passage together as a Group.

• John 14:16; Ephesians 1:13-14, 4:30, 5:18

Discussion Questions: Pick a few questions below to guide your time.

Starting Sharing: Choose a question or two to create openness.

- Share a time you were part of something significant. How did you contribute?
- What comes to mind when you hear "Holy Spirit"?
- Do you find it easy to ask for help or guidance? Why or why not?

Start Thinking: Choose a question or two to think critically about the subject.

- What do you believe is your purpose? Why do you exist?
- How is the Holy Spirit different from conscience?
- Why is it short-sighted to confuse hardship in life with God's judgment, absence, or apathy?

Make it Personal: Choose a question or two to help you identify your best next step.

- How do you listen to God's nudges in your life? What would it look like to say yes and follow through on those promptings?
- When was a time you heard or felt God asking you to do something but chose not to follow through?
- What is stopping you from taking the help that Jesus has given us in the Helper?

Next Steps: Everybody has a next step. Check out some ideas below to help you grow by doing.

- **Invite-** At the Movies is better with others. Invite a friend, family member, co-worker, neighbor, or anyone else to join you. Check out our **digital invite tools**.
- **Pause-** Take time to slow down and pay attention to God's nudges. When you find yourself needing direction, ask for help.
