Discussion Questions:

Question 1: Were you raised in an environment that was inclusive and diverse or exclusive and uniform?

Question 2: The Titans didn't want to integrate to form one school and one team. What do you think were some of the fears and lies that surrounded their bias to keep segregated?

Question 3: Looking back to the Civil Rights Era, how have we made progress towards racial reconciliation? In what areas do we still have work to do?

Read Ephesians 4:1-6

Question 4: Why is it essential to approach the topic of Race with humility? Do you think our culture is more prone to listen or offer opinions surrounding the tension over racial disparity?

Question 5: How can we create a safe place for people to be in the process? What are some practical ways of not giving up on one another?

Question 6: What would it look like in your world this week to work for peace?

Next Steps:

- **Examine your heart-** Like the Titans, each of us has known and hidden bias that affects how we see those around us. Take time to reflect on what you believe about those who are different than you.
- **Start small-** Big change is often the result of small steps. Reach out to those who are different than you, beginning with people in your circle. Who is a neighbor, co-worker, or acquaintance that you can get to know?
