



For The One, Week 4

“Jesus has always been for the one. Pausing, listening, looking for the one who feels unworthy, broken, rejected. His mission is unrelentingly set on rescue. And he invites us to join him.

Conversation Starter: *Have some fun as you break the ice.*

- What is something that makes it hard for you to focus?
- Share a time God wowed you- doing something incredible for you or someone you love.

Key Scriptures: *Let God’s word frame the conversation. Take a minute to read this selected passage together as a Group.*

- *Luke 10:1-12, 17-20; Luke 15:3-7; John 14:12*

Discussion Questions: *Pick a few of the questions below to guide your time.*

Starting Sharing: *Choose a question or two to create openness.*

- What is something that causes you to celebrate or rejoice?
- Who is someone that helped you understand the love God had for you?
- Share a time you introduced someone to Jesus or played a role in their story of life change.

Start Thinking: *Choose a question or two to think critically about the subject.*

- How are Christians guilty of misdefining what’s “miraculous”?
- What are some good things that cause us to lose sight of the best or most important things?
- If followers of Jesus truly believed that Heaven threw a party every time a lost person becomes found, what would change the way we live?

Make it Personal: *Choose a question or two to help you identify your best next step.*

- Who is someone you want to experience spiritual life through Jesus’ forgiveness?
- How has God been nudging you to be part of For the One?
- What excites you about God wanting to use you to move his mission forward?

Next Steps: *Everybody has a next step. Check out some ideas below to help you grow by doing.*

- **Talk to God-** Ask God what role you could play in helping us continue to be a church that relentlessly pursues those who don’t yet know Jesus.
- **Respond to His nudges-** As you talk to God, listen for his leading and do what He says to do.

Prayer: *Invite God to do what only He can do!*

Heavenly Father, thank you for pursuing us even when we were far off. Please give us the heart to seek out and celebrate when your radical love and forgiveness change a life. May we be laser-focused on the rescue mission you launched 2,000 years ago. Please keep us from getting distracted by lesser things. Amen.
