KEY SCRIPTURE

John 21:1-19

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. Of the disciples, John was young and naïve, Andrew was very friendly and introduced people to Jesus, Matthew was a social-reject-turned-disciple and Peter was impulsive and strong. Of all these personalities, which one do you most relate to?
2. Do you have a hard time forgiving yourself when you mess up? How?
3. Why do you think the disciples had a hard time getting started after Jesus rose from the dead?

SO NOW WHAT?

1. Was there ever a time you stopped following Jesus? What happened?
2. Do you feel like your relationship with God is strong right now? What do you wish there was more of or less of in your experience with Jesus?
3. Jesus tells Peter that there is a lot of work to do and he is needed to 'feed my sheep.' Is there something that you feel like God has for you to do in life? Or in the church or in this group? What is it?
4. How can you help feed the sheep?

PRAYER

Pray that God would reveal what it is that He has for you to do with your life.
