### **GROUP VISION:**

It takes time to craft a vision that's worth following. To help you clarify where God might be leading you to lead your Group, remember the three values of Groups;

#### **Belonging - Groups are a place where everyone has a seat.**

Just as we want to create a church that is open to everyone, we want our Groups to have a seat for whoever is ready to take this step. Groups are a place where people find acceptance and a sense of belonging no matter where they happen to be on their journey with Jesus.

#### **Becoming** - Challenge each other to listen to God and do what he says.

In a Group, we get the unique opportunity to know others on a deeper level. As leaders, we need to gauge where our members are on their journey with Jesus and help them identify and act on their best next step. Life change is a process that takes place over time. We need to give people time and space to process and grow while challenging them to step out in obedience as they follow Jesus. Any time we can get someone to apply God's truth, we're winning.

• At the end of your 6-8 weeks together, what do you want people to know?

• What are some ways you can invest in your Group members in order to get to know their story and earn the right to speak into their best next step?

**Building** - We find practical ways to impact our community from across the street to across the state through intentionally building relationships and serving others.

We add value to the lives of others. This could mean serving together as a Group in our community or encouraging each Group member to invest in their spheres of influence. Bottom line – we want to be good neighbors, and we do that by building into those around us.

### **GROUP FLOW**
