



## LIFE Group Curriculum - Week 5

This Facilitator Guide will help you lead conversation with your LIFE Group.

[Brackets] indicate simple cues for you as a Facilitator, not intended to be read aloud.

### Conversation Starter

What do you get really excited about? Is it a sport or team, a hobby, or even food?

[Play the Recap Video, then move into Discussion Questions.]

### Discussion Questions

**Question 1:** Who has been a Hero in your life? [This could be someone who introduced you to Jesus, invited you to church, rescued you in some way.]

**Question 2:** David listed three significant words: urgency, risk, and priorities.

- Urgency - Why do we not feel a greater sense of urgency when eternity is at stake?
- Risk - Why are we not willing to pay the price to do something heroic?
- Priorities - Why do we get more excited about football games than we do about introducing people to Jesus?

Which of these words do you get hung up on and why?

**Question 3:** Read Luke 18:26-27. Thinking of the name that you wrote on the pallet, how can this passage of scripture encourage you to keep praying for that one life?

### Challenge

Considering the One Life campaign, what are two ways that you can continue to take risks, reorient your priorities, and live with urgency to introduce people to Jesus?

### Pray

Pray for the names written on the pallets. Ask God to lead you in boldness to take risks, invite others, and make introducing people to Jesus a priority.
