Discussion Questions:

Question I: When discussing difficult subjects, do you tend to keep quiet out of fear of being misunderstood, or fear of being hurt?

Question 2: Intentions and impact are two different things, but both are equally important. Why can't we separate one from the other even if they aren't the same?

Question 3: Share a time when your good intentions didn't come across so well.

Question 4: Assuming positive intent is going to be critical for our time as a Group. What are some practical ways to help us believe the best possible story for everyone represented here?

Question 5: What comes to mind when you hear the word humility?

Question 6: B**r**itish writer C.S. Lewis once wrote, "Humility is not thinking less of yourself; it is thinking of yourself less." How can taking the focus of our preferences or viewpoints help us to find common ground with others?

Question 7: To humble ourselves, we need to admit we need God's help to navigate these conversations well. What do you need to cast onto God as we begin this journey together?

Next Steps:

- **Examine Your Heart-** This week, check your motives. Are you more concerned with preserving your thoughts and opinions, or are you ready to engage in the hard work of humility?
- **Talk to God-** Continue to be honest with God about where you are and remember to cast your cares on Him because He cares for you!
