*This is a 29hr/week position that involves serving in our weekend gatherings. Compensation varies based on stage of life and work experience.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) Who should apply for the Production Program?

The production program is designed for anyone who has production interest and a desire to work in a local church setting.

2) Can I work a part-time job?

Yes, each staff member can work a part-time job, but DEVELUP must take priority over any outside work.

3) When does the DEVELUP program begin?

Each staff member should be moved and ready to start work at LCBC by August 1.

4) Is housing provided?

Yes, we have a limited number of on-site housing options that are available at no cost to each staff member in the production program.

5) What happens once I complete the DEVELUP program?

Completing the program does not obligate LCBC to provide a current or future staff position. However, based on each person's growth and performance, the DEVELUP Program Director may serve as a reference towards a staff position at LCBC or another like-minded church.
