PITCHES/REST

SPRING SEASON
 1-45 NO REST
 46-65 2 NIGHTS
 66-100 3 NIGHTS

MAXIMUM 100 PITCHES IN A DAY

SINGLE/SUMMER SEASON
 1-50 NO REST
 51-75 2 NIGHTS
 76-115 3 NIGHTS
 (105 FOR 18U AA)

MAXIMUM 115 PITCHES IN A DAY

Exception: If a pitcher reaches their limit while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until that batter reaches a base or is put out
 Pitcher CANNOT pitch on 4 consecutive days may pitch on 3 consecutive days if TOTAL CUMULATIVE PITCH COUNT for DAY 1 & DAY 2 IS LESS than the No Rest Limit (Reference Rule 24.01)
