Holly is entering her third season as assistant director of Red Storm volleyball. She is the head coach of the 13s National and 16s National teams. Last season her Red Storm 15s National team finished 9th at AAU Nationals. She rejoins the Red Storm family after serving as the assistant coach for Gardner-Webb University in 2018. Prior to Gardner-Webb Holly spent the previous two seasons at Mississippi College, where she was a graduate assistant for the 2016 season before being named the interim head coach in October 2017 as one of the youngest head coaches in the NCAA. Tupper was also a standout player at Mississippi College, where she ranks among the career leaders in program history. She stands as the career leader in digs with 1,825 and is sixth all-time in service aces with 78, and also had four of the top-six single season digs marks in team history. Tupper earned All-Southwest Conference honorable mention honors on three occasions during her playing career and was also a standout in the classroom, being named to the conference honor roll three times, as well as NCCAA Volleyball Scholar-Athlete Team honors her senior season. Tupper earned her Masters of Applied Exercise Physiology from Mississippi College in May 2018. Holly is originally from Baton Rouge, La. where she graduated from The Dunham School. She played for Red Storm Volleyball under the leadership of Donna Pixley.
