



CINNAMINSON BASEBALL PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT



As a teammate, players must understand that it is their responsibility to attend all team functions and to respect and obey the coach while at team activities. It is also their responsibility to do everything they can to improve their skills as a player by practicing on their own in addition to team practices. Above all else, players must demonstrate good sportsmanship to their teammates and to other teams and will show respect for the authority of the coaches and umpires when on the field.

Players must agree to the following principals:

- Respect all coaches, players, league officials, umpires, spectators, and opponents. Players must not use abusive or profane language, taunt or embarrass any other player, or use “chatter” designed to distract a pitcher or batter.
- Be a good teammate by giving support and encouragement; treating them fairly the way that you would want to be treated.
- Give 100% of your effort in practice – hustle all of the time
- Give my best effort in listening and learning from coaches.
- Learn from my mistakes.
- Display good sportsmanship and team play at all times.
- Be humble and generous in victory and proud and courteous in defeat.
- Follow the direction of the coaching staff.
- Make every attempt to be on time and ready to play for all games and practices.
- Follow safety rules and do not endanger the well-being of others on the field (e.g. being aware of a player’s surroundings when throwing a ball or swinging a baseball bat).
- Take care of league equipment. Players must not abuse, mistreat or mishandle any league or personal baseball equipment or property (e.g. throwing batting helmets).
- Leave other player’s equipment alone unless you have permission to use it.
- Show respect for the game of baseball by knowing and following the rules of the game, by controlling your emotions when calls don’t go your way and by respecting the decisions of the umpire and coaches. Players must not question an umpire’s call.
- Refrain from the use of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol at all sports events.

I agree to abide by the policies outlined in this code of conduct. Further, I acknowledge that if I fail to comply with aforementioned rules and guidelines, I may be subject to disciplinary action levied by the Cinnaminson Baseball Board of Directors that could include, but are not limited to, (1) verbal warning, (2) written warning, (3) ejection from a game, (4) game suspension, (4) season suspension, and/or (5) removal from all league activities.
