

# FWSA FIELDS CHEAT SHEET

## Contact/Location Info

- **Fairfax County Lights Supervisor: (703) 609-8870**  
Contact directly if the lights do not come on even after several attempts (but note that you push the button once and wait a few minutes – the lights restart each time the button is pushed).
- **Evening and Weekend Emergency Line: (703) 609-8870**  
Call if people are loitering on or near fields, or harassing teams. There are monitors that will come out to address issues if alerted.
- **Police Non-Emergency Numbers:**  
If monitors are not able to come to the field, you may call these non-emergency numbers for the respective fields to request an officer to be dispatched if available.

**Field Closures:** Turf fields are rarely closed and typically only for extreme weather conditions (e.g., snow or flooding on the field) or for technical difficulties (e.g., lights not working). If the county field status does not post that a field is closed, assume the game is on. Then games are only called off at the field by the referee(s).

**Dog Policies:** All players must abide by the dog policies of the fields.

PARKS: Leashed dogs are allowed at parks but must be kept off playing fields.

SCHOOLS: NO dogs are allowed on school grounds unless a service animal and should be clearly identifiable as such (i.e., wears a distinctly marked service vest or harness).

NOTE: If you bring your dog to a field, know that it is solely your responsibility to ensure your dog is leashed, does not enter the playing field, is not disruptive and is cleaned up after. If not, this can become a liability for the league and may jeopardize the ability to obtain and keep permits.

### **Team Equipment Responsibilities - Woodson:**

FIRST GAME: Both teams are responsible for arriving to the field early to setup goals, etc.

LAST GAME: Both teams are responsible for putting goals back as well as returning flags

## Lights - Pine Ridge 4, 6, Wakefield & Woodson Aux

The lights are programmed remotely but can be turned on and off at the field. If they are not on, they will need to be manually turned on at the light control box.

### Light Control Locations:

- Pine Ridge #4: on the green electrical box toward the baseball field.
- Pine Ridge #6: outside the fence to the left of the field when looking from the parking lot.
- Wakefield #5: near side of field toward the tennis courts
- Woodson Aux: on green electrical box by gate to the stadium

Press and hold the button for a second, you will hear a "click". Do not press the button more than once. If you do, it will take another 15 min. to reset. If the lights get turned off for some reason they will have to cool off (about 15 min.) before they can be turned back on. If you have the early game and there is no game after yours on that field, please turn the lights off.

## Woodson Fields – Goals and Equipment

### Woodson Auxiliary Field (Turf):

- Goals - Location: Lined up on the fence adjacent to the parking lot and labeled BRYC.
- Lock Box = **0320**
- Goals – Combo: **0430**
- Blue Equipment Box: Flags and sandbags are to be stored inside. Combo = **5025**
- Front gate: **DO NOT LOCK!!** Gate should be open, if not, call the NCS afterhours number for someone to come and unlock it: 703-609-8870

### Woodson Stadium (Turf):

- Goals - Location: Stored behind the netting closest to the main entrance between the track and runway for the high jump. Please put goals back here.
- Goals – Combo: **0918** Locked using a key lock. Keys for the goals can be found in a LOCKBOX that is attached to the fence on the visitor's side of the stadium.
- Equipment: Corner flags and sandbags for the stadium field are stored in the right-most blue shed on the Grass field. COMBO = **0316**. When returning equipment be sure to put it back neatly on the LEFT side.

### Woodson East (Bermuda Grass):

- Goals – Location: Stored together on the fence line.
- Goals – Combo: There is a lock box attached to the fence to the right of the goals, there is a key that unlocks the goals. Combo = **0320**
- Equipment: There is a blue equipment shed is located on Woodson's East Grass field. Sandbags, wagon, turf & grass corner flags are stored inside. Comb = **0316** When returning equipment be sure to put it back neatly on the LEFT side.
