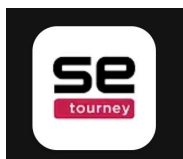

Tournament Pricing

Youth tournament fees are \$40 per tournament. Sign your player up for each individual tournament with LeagueApp after your player has been registered to a team. A \$20 late fee will be added 1 week before the tournament date.

Example: Headwater Classic registration fee is \$40 from Jan 6th- April 18th. A \$20 late fee will be added to your invoice starting April 19th.

Gear Rental Information

Rental packages are for 4th graders and younger players ONLY. **Rental for 5/6 players is HELMET ONLY**

Boys packages only include a lacrosse stick, helmet, gloves, shoulder pads, and arm pads.

*Personal protective equipment such as athletic supporters (cups), cleats, and mouth guards are not included.

Girls package only includes a lacrosse stick and helmet.

*mouth guards not included

Youth Uniforms/Pinnies

Uniform pinnies are provided to each registered player free of charge. Uniform jerseys are property of TVYLA and must be returned upon completion of the season. If uniforms are not returned, a replacement fee of \$50 will be charged to $\frac{5}{6}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and k/2 players. $\frac{7}{8}$ players will be charged \$100. Normal wear and tear are expected.

Communication

LeagueApp is our preferred method of communication. You won't be able to receive texts or messages from coaches or other teammates until you verify your phone number with LeagueApp.

Scholarship Information

The Teton Valley Youth Lacrosse Association is committed to finding a way for every child who wants to play lacrosse to participate. TVYLA will set aside funds on an annual basis and dedicate them for scholarship use. Those funds will vary from year to year based on what funds are available. Play Time Expectation

TVYLA is dedicated to developing not only great athletes, but great humans. Lacrosse should be fun, challenging, and a rewarding endeavor. Winning games/tournaments is not necessarily the goal, but competing and player development is. As competition increases throughout a student athlete's career, so does the allotment of playing time. We have adopted the below policy to communicate expectations as they relate to playing time:

- K / 2 grades: 100% Fun (Retention based - equal play)
- 3 / 4 grades: 90% Fun, 10% competitive (Retention based - equal play)
- 5 / 6 grades: 50% Fun, 50% Competitive
- 7 / 8 grades: 30% Fun, 70% Competitive
- Highschool: 10% Fun, 90% Competitive

Players that excel at lacrosse (and tend to be rewarded with more playing time) show the following characteristics. Please note that these ARE NOT SKILL ORIENTATED:

- Work hard in practice and games
- Are good teammates
 - Encourage others to do their best
 - Do not place blame on others
 - Show concern for others
 - Willing to do what is best for the development and success of the overall team
- Make an effort to execute tasks when directed by the coaches
- Ask questions if they don't understand what a coach is asking/saying
- Work on stick skills outside of practice
- Attend most practices (and are on-time)
- Improve on understanding and executing basic lacrosse concepts throughout the season

Volunteer Hours

In order to continue developing our nonprofit Youth Lacrosse program, parents are required to volunteer a minimum of **10 hours per player**. K/2 and 3/4 players' parents are only required to volunteer **5 hours per player**. While many of our volunteer opportunities are offered during the spring season, our organization has ways to volunteer year round!

For families with multiple children registered with TVYLA, the deposit and the volunteer hours commitment will be capped at 2 children. A \$100 deposit per child (maximum deposit \$200) in the form of CHECK written to 'TVYLA' will be held, but not cashed, to insure this commitment by all families. When the volunteer hours are completed, the check will be shredded. If volunteer hours are not completed and reported by **Thursday October 31, 2025** the deposit will be cashed and donated to TVYLA the following Monday.

Please note:

- Volunteer deposit must be in hand before the first practice in order for your child to participate.
- Please make check out to: TVYLA. Check Date: **Oct 31, 2025**
- Checks can be dropped off at Gear Pick Up (date: TBD), given to your team parent or mailed to TVYLA at PO Box 874, Victor ID 83455
- EXEMPTIONS:
 - 1. Coaches who have coached two seasons or more for TVYLA and are currently coaches for the 2024-2025 season are exempt from this deposit.
 - 2. If you have more than two kids participating in the program the third child is exempt. We have capped this deposit at 2 players or \$200.

Volunteer Opportunities

Opportunities include coaching, helping at the Mountain West Youth Tournament, fundraising, being a team parent, Tin Cup committee, helping with our 4th Annual Golf Tournament, working the scoreboard table at games, end of the season party, helping with social media posts, grant writing, selling swag at away tournaments and more.

Additional Information

Refunds:

- ~Illness refund: Should our season be canceled due to illness a prorated refund will be issued commensurate with the point of season.
- ~Injury refund policy: Once your child has attended two practices or more, the only refunds available are for medical conditions.
- ~Prior to April 7th, medical refunds for the entire tuition will be given at the amount of 100% straight refund
- ~After April 7th, medical refunds for the entire tuition will be given at the amount of 50% straight refund
- ~NO medical refunds will be granted after April 21st.
- ~One practice policy: We understand that sometimes a program doesn't end up matching the needs of a child. Your child can attend ONE practice and still receive a full refund if the program does not meet their needs.
