As the season approaches, please take note of the following updates and reminders:

- **Team Rosters:** Team rosters will be posted to the PLL [LeagueApps Play](#) app over Labor Day Weekend. The app is used throughout the season to share updates and reminders. The League also uses [text messaging](#) to communicate any time-sensitive information.
- **Fall Registration:** We have opened additional spots for fall players league ages 4-12 and have cleared waitlisted players. Fall registration remains open for these programs.
- **Practices and Games:** Fall teams will practice once a week and play one game each Saturday. Practices begin next week, and games start on Saturday, September 7, and run through October 26. You should expect practice and game times to align with the expectations set during registration.
 - Practice schedules will be posted in the app with team rosters. For most teams, practice times change in early October to account for shorter daylight hours.
 - There will be a delay in posting the game schedules as we are waiting on scheduling information for our fall teams participating in inter-town play programs. This primarily affects our softball and 13-16-year-old baseball teams. However, this information is essential for finalizing our schedule for all teams to ensure we can best utilize our fields.
- **Field Locations and Facilities:** Field locations for all practices and games are listed in the app. Restrooms are available at all locations. Each location is equipped with an AED and is in the same building as the bathrooms. In an emergency, the 911 operator will direct you to the AED's location, as our AEDs are registered with Monroe County. We welcome dogs on leashes at all our locations, and food concessions will be available at our Ford and Habecker field locations during games each Saturday.
- **Equipment:** Information regarding player equipment requirements can be found in your registration confirmation message and in each program description on our registration pages.
