



2019 All Star Player Commitment Form

It's that time of the season when we start thinking about All Stars!

Interested All-Star participants, including parents and family, need to ask some tough questions and answer honestly before making the All-Star commitment.

Are you ready for the time & financial commitment?

Are you ready for 3-4 hour practices 4 times a week?

Are you willing to change that vacation, or simply give it up for this year?

Can you objectively support your manager without questioning their decisions related to how often or what position(s) your daughter plays?

Can you represent MGS, your community and your softball sisters with honor and respect at all times?

Are you ready to support MGS (Your Manager, coaches, team members, board of directors and So Cal USA) 100%?

If you have any reservations, then an All-Star commitment may not be right for you.

If you can honestly answer yes to these questions, without hesitation, then you are ready to consider an All-Star commitment.

All-Star Participant Cost: \$350.00 Due at or before Uniform Fittings (5/1/19)

Payments can be made by MGS Website, CC/Debit, or Personal Sponsorships (which are also required by uniform fittings)

There is significant financial commitment associated with being an All-Star that is to be the responsibility of each team. MGS will purchase All-Star player uniform for each selected

All-Star which will include: 2 Jerseys, 2 pairs of Pants, 2 pairs of Socks

*Cleats, bat bags, helmets, practice tees, decals, and any other apparel/equipment not specifically paid for by MGS is the responsibility of the individual team and families.

*Fundraisers and sponsorships can be organized by the team to cover the extras.

*Spirit wear will be available for purchase through the league.

When there are tournaments in other cities most teams like to stay in a hotel and have that team bonding experience. All travel expenses and lodging are the responsibility of each team and their families.

TIME COMMITMENT

Our tournament schedule is as follows:

Teams could potentially practice seven days a week beginning May 2, 2019. Practice times, locations and durations are at the manager's discretion, but can be up to 4 hours long. Your time with other parents and teammates will blossom into a close-knit relationship that will be remembered by all for years to come.

Being an All-Star takes a tremendous amount of time, dedication, and commitment by both the players and parents. The tournament season runs through the summer...A popular time for vacations. The team must be placed ahead of vacation time for during tournament season. Being an All-Star is a great honor, and it is the final reward for your efforts throughout the year and a chance for you to move to the next level of competition.

PLAYING TIME

Each All-Star team will consist of up to 12 players, and positions and playing time is at the sole discretion of the All-Star manager. The essential rules from the regular playing season such as equal playing time and batting the complete roster do not apply during the All-Star season. The managers/coaches will play the All-Star players where they feel is the best for the team. In some cases, the manager may only select to bat nine (9) players, use the DP/Flex system, or bat the whole team. It is up to the All-Star managers/coaches and tournament rules, as how to manage the team. There is the possibility that your daughter will not play but an inning or two throughout the All-Star season. While we, as a Board, hope this does not happen, please note that the Board does not control this matter, as it is at the sole discretion of the All-Star managers to make all necessary playing decisions.

If a manager, coach, or player did not fulfill their commitment in any previous All-Star season (i.e. quit the team, was removed from the team, or in any way the Board deemed violated the contract), they will not be eligible for All-Star consideration for the present season.

By agreeing to take part in Menifee USA All Stars you are stating that you are eligible to play. To be eligible to play USA All-Stars your daughter must not have participated with any other All-Star or travel type team, including USA or non-USA after March 31st of this year. Participation is defined as “a player taking part in a try-out, practice, practice game, scheduled game, or tournament.”

The parent/legal guardian and player must sign this letter and turn it (page 4) in by 5:00 PM, Friday April 21st 2018. Otherwise, the player will not be eligible for the All-Star team selection process.

ALL STAR TRYOUTS will be held on April 28th. Location and Times TBD. ALL interested player MUST attend this try-out.
