



All-Star Policy Framework

The All-Star Committee is responsible for determining:

- The cost of registration per girl, and what will be included in that registration.
 - Based on availability of funds, and approval of the Board of Directors, MGS may provide players and coaching staff with uniforms.
- Number of tournaments played.
- Where and when the tournaments will be played.

The All-Star Committee will also determine the number of teams participating for each league level. If more than one (1) from each league level is sent to all-star tournaments, then the teams for those leagues will be organized into tournament teams with each team designated. The All-Star Committee will count final ballots for players and managers.

All-Star Manager Guidelines

Tournament Managers, Coaches and assistant coaches must apply for the position by signing a commitment form that is handed out during the last half of the spring season. The form must also be turned in by the designated date, as determined by and published by the All-Star Committee, to be eligible. No forms will be accepted after that date. Each applicant may only apply for one division. Managers must meet all requirements, as set forth by the MGS Board and published at the beginning of the season, and USA Softball Rules, to be eligible for the tournament manager ballot. Applying for a manager position does not guarantee placement of the applicant's daughter to a tournament team.

Each manager, coach (two [2] per team maximum) and every eligible member of the All-Star Committee shall vote for one (1) tournament team eligible manager for the league level they were managing/coaching in during the spring season. No write-ins allowed.

- Members of the All-Star Committee cannot vote for a manager in the division their daughter is trying out for.
- Members of the All-Star Committee cannot vote for a manager in the division that their spouse or significant other has applied for

The manager getting the top number of votes will be assigned the first team. He may pick a maximum of two (2) other league managers or coaches to act as his coaching staff.

If a second team is decided upon the next available manager from the eligible managers on the tournament team ballot will be assigned this team. If no manager is available from the ballot for a particular league level, the All-Star Committee may choose to go to other league managers, at all levels and who may wish to have a tournament team but did not turn in the commitment form in time, to get a team formed. If this fails to heed a manager, no second team will be formed. The manager assigned to the team may pick two (2) other league managers or coaches to fill out their staff.



All-Star Player Guidelines

All regular season players must sign a commitment form for post-season play in order to be considered for the tournament teams. The form must also be turned in by the designated date, as determined by and published by the All-Star Committee, to be eligible. No forms will be accepted after that date. Players need to meet all requirements, as set forth by the MGS Board and published at the beginning of the season, and USA Softball Rules, to be eligible for the tournament team ballot.

- Managers may not evaluate or vote for their own daughters.
- The all star committee members may not evaluate or vote for their own daughters.

First Team Selected

Teams will have a maximum of twelve (12) players.

The players getting the most votes, top eight (8) finishers, will be placed on the team first.

The manager will then pick four (4) more eligible players from the tournament team ballot to complete their roster upon All-Star Committee approval.

Second Team Selected (if needed)

Team will have a maximum of twelve (12) players.

The remaining eligible players on the tournament team ballot are available for this team. The next eight (8) finishers in votes will be placed on this team.

The manager will then pick four (4) more eligible players from the tournament team ballot to complete their roster upon All-Star Committee approval.
