

Code of Conduct

The code of conduct refers to the behavior of any person, player, or spectator involved in any way with the Platte County Parks & Recreation District's youth sports programs.

- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain or coach approach the official during a break or after the game in an appropriate manner.
- Control your temper, verbal and physical abuse of officials, Platte County Parks & Recreation district employees, or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted by the Platte County Parks & Recreation District.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your team's performance will benefit, and so will you.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully, or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Attend all practices. If you are unable to, call the coach to inform him/her. If you miss a practice and have not contacted your coach you are responsible for finding out when the next practice is.
- Play for the fun of it, not just to win or to please spectators or teammates.
- Avoid the use of inappropriate language, or actions.
- This is a recreational program. Our purpose is to provide opportunities for physical activity, enjoyment, modified game play, life experiences, and skill development.
- Applaud good performances from each team. Congratulate all players regardless of the outcome.
- Respect the official's decision. Be a good sport.
- If you encounter a problem, please make arrangements to talk to the coach off the field or court. If the problem cannot be resolved between you and the coach, a meeting may be scheduled with a Platte County Parks & Recreation representative, yourself, and the coach.
- Never ridicule or abuse a participant for making a mistake. Be positive.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, or players.
- Show respect for your team's opponents, without them there would be no game.
- Encourage participants to obey rules and decisions of officials or coaches
- Demonstrate appropriate social behavior by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches, or officials.

Concerns should be brought to the attention of the Platte County Parks & Recreation Director, Program Supervisor, or Program Representative.
